- **AND WHEREAS** Louis Riel has made an enormous contribution towards the development of this country, and British Columbia recognizes November 16, "Louis Riel Day", as a national Metis holiday in commemoration of the anniversary of the death of Louis Riel;
- **AND WHEREAS** this November 16, marks the 130th anniversary of Louis Riel's death;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT I, Andy Adams, Mayor of the City of Campbell River, do hereby declare November 16th, 2015
