Dig;

Ground disturbers, including contractors, municipal workers,

homeowners and landowners can save time and money and keep our province safe and connected by following Damage Prevention best Practices including making that one simple call to BC One-

The stakeholders in the buried facility damage prevention process - the digging community, buried facility owners/operators, buried facility locators, regulatory agencies, training organizations and the one-call centre - all agree that the prevention of damage to

buried facilities is a shared responsibility.
