FOR WATER, SEWER, STORM WATER AND PARKS PARCEL TAX ASSESSMENT PURPOSES

NOTICE is hereby given that a Parcel Tax Review Panel for Water, Sewer, Storm Water and Parks Parcel Tax Assessment purposes will be held at 9:00 am on Wednesday, April 22, 2015 in the Council Chambers of City Hall at 301 St. Ann's Road in Campbell River, BC to hear complaints regarding the Water, Sewer, Storm Water and Parks Rolls for the year 2015.

You may make a complaint under Section 205 of the Community Charter to the Parcel Tax Review Panel for one or more of the following reasons:

- There is an error or omission about a name or address on the tax roll;
- There is an error or omission about the inclusion of a parcel;
- There is an error or omission about the taxable area or taxable frontage of a parcel;
- An exemption has been improperly allowed.

For a complaint to be heard by the Parcel Tax Review Panel, the complaint must be received in writing on or before 9:00 am, April 20, 2015 to the attention of:

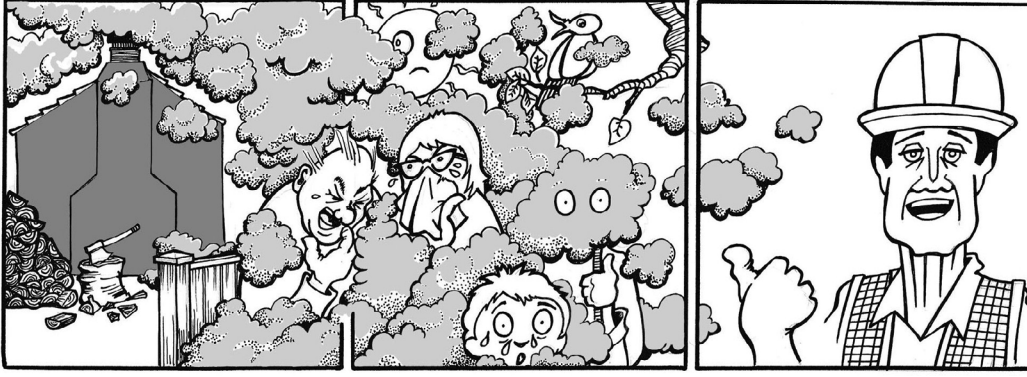
