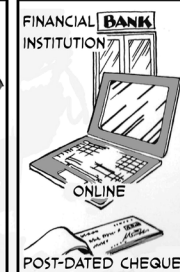
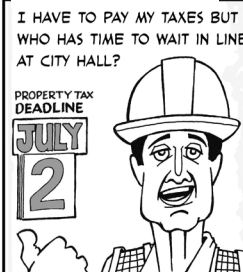

PROPERTY TAX DEADLINE JULY 2
Avoid the lineups! Mail your post-dated cheque or place it in the drop box at the front door to City Hall. Or make a payment online via your financial institution or use telephone banking. For more information, see the Frequently Asked Questions document posted online at www.campbellriver.ca. If you are interested in monthly pre-authorized withdrawals for payment of next year's taxes, look for the application form included with this year's tax notice mail out. Remember to claim your Home Owner Grant by July 2, 2015 to avoid a late penalty!

Coming to City Hall to pay your taxes? We're making more room for you!

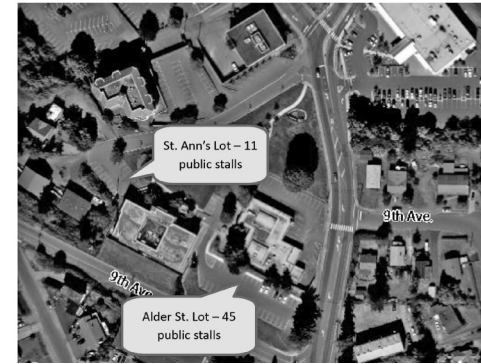
From June 22 to July 2 (inclusive) additional public parking is available at City Hall.

Please park in the larger City Hall parking lot with access off the Alder street hill.

Signs will be placed to direct vehicle traffic to the Alder street parking lot where more parking stalls are available for public use.

The smaller parking lot at the top of St. Ann's remains available for public parking – but is limited to only 11 stalls.

Property taxes and Home Owner Grants are due July 2, 2015.



Notice of Intention To Provide Assistance By Way Of A Partnering Agreement

Pursuant to Section 21 of the *Community Charter*, the Council of the City of Campbell River intends to provide assistance to the Campbellton Neighbourhood Association under the terms of a partnering agreement for the provision of services to beautify and provide public amenities on public property in the Campbellton area, including a banner project and community garden project.

The agreement is for work being done in 2015. The extent of the City's assistance under the Partnering Agreement shall not exceed \$10,000.

The draft Partnering Agreement and records relating to the proposed assistance are available for public inspection between the hours of 8:30 am to 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday, excluding holidays, at City Hall, 301 St. Ann's Road, Campbell River, BC.
