NOTICE OF DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY

Pursuant to Sections 24 and 26 of the *Community Charter*

TAKE NOTICE that the City of Campbell River (the "City") has disposed of the land legally described as follows:

1. Mclvor Lake

Lot 1, District Lot 87, Sayward District, Plan 27013, PID: 002-526-565

5-year Licence of Occupation Agreement from June 1, 2016 and terminating on May 31, 2021, to the Campbell River Eagles Water Ski Club, for a fee of \$1.00.

The City has also leased the following land at the Campbell River Airport:

1. 25-year lease from April 1, 2016 through March 31, 2041 with an option to renew for one (1) further term of twenty-five (25) years (Lease Area 4, Plan EPP35390) to DEFAB Enterprises, for an initial annual rent of \$1,775.95 plus GST.

Please note that the City will remain the registered, fee-simple owner of all lands described above.
