Members of the public will have the opportunity to provide Council with comments and suggestions on the Financial Plan at the beginning of Monday's meeting starting at 9:30 am (5 minute maximum per presentation).

People unable to attend in person are invited to send their comments in writing by either emailing them to the City's Finance Manager myriah.foort@campbellriver.ca or by delivering or mailing them to City Hall: 301 St. Ann's Road, Campbell River, BC, V9W 4C7. A mail drop box is available at front door for after-hours submissions. In order for Council to consider written comments it is recommended that they be received at City Hall as soon as possible. Council will not have an opportunity to review written comments received after 8:30 a.m. on Monday, Dec. 5. However, as noted members of the public are encouraged to provide feedback verbally at the Monday Dec. 5 Financial Plan meeting starting at 9:30 am.

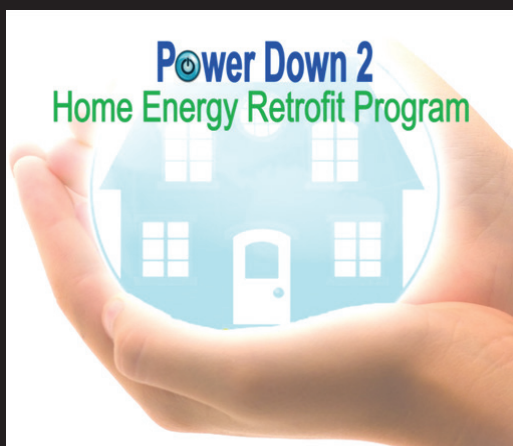
