CITY INTENDS TO PROVIDE BEAUTIFICATION GRANTS

Campbell River City Council has approved in principle plans to support the following organizations through partnering agreements and grant funding.

- **Heart of the City Business Improvement Area Association** – up to \$5,950 for 2017 for sign installation, pressure washing and leaf blowing in downtown public areas.
- **Willow Point Business Improvement Area Society** – up to \$5,870 for 2017 for supply and installation of Christmas lighting in Willow Point.
- **Campbellton Neighbourhood Association** – up to \$10,000 for 2017 for garden planter boxes and art banners on streetlight posts in Campbellton.
- **Pier Street Association** – up to \$10,000 for 2017 planter maintenance, tree pruning, general site maintenance, pressure washing, and the purchase and replacement of two benches in the Pier Street area.

The City is required to issue public notice of this intention according to section 21 of the Community Charter.

The draft partnering agreements and records relating to the proposed assistance are available for public inspection between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays, at City Hall, 301 St. Ann's Road, Campbell River, BC.
