**Modifications to log peeling plant successfully reduce noise**

Independent consultants have confirmed that noise coming from the log peeling operation on Duncan Bay Road has been reduced.

A letter from BKL Sound Consultants confirmed to City Council that the plant owners have *“fully implemented the noise abatement methods approved by the City.”*

The modifications to the plant and certification that modifications had successfully reduced the sound of the operation were required by Campbell River’s Public Nuisance Bylaw.

*“The modifications to the plant have been very successful in reducing the noise from the de-barker, to the point where it no longer contravenes the City’s noise regulations,”* said City Clerk Peter Wipper.

A copy of the letter, along with a staff report was distributed with Council’s July 24 meeting agenda.
