Notice to drivers: temporary road closure this week at Dogwood and 16th intersection

The intersection at Dogwood and 16th Avenue will be closed Wednesday and Thursday, Sept. 19 and 20 for re-paving.

From 7:30 a.m. through 6 p.m. on Wednesday and Thursday. Flaggers will be in place to direct traffic through temporary detours to allow crews to prepare and pave this area. All traffic will be detoured around the site.

Recommended alternative routes:

- **Travelling west:** 13th Ave to Ironwood
- **Travelling east:** 13th Ave to Shoppers Row
- **Travelling north:** right on 13th Ave, left on Cedar, right on 16th, left onto Robert's Reach or left onto 13th, right on Ironwood, left on 16th and right on Maple
- **Travelling south:** Roberts Reach right on 16th, left on Cedar, right on 13th left on to Dogwood or right on Maple, left on 16th, right on Ironwood, left on 13th, right onto Dogwood

Drivers are cautioned that manhole covers and utility boxes will be exposed and clearly marked for after-hours passage through the intersection.

The City has notified the school district and emergency services and will distribute letters to properties within a block of the intersection to ensure people are aware of the temporary closure at this intersection.
