Summer Road Closures and Detours Announced for Downtown Construction in the St Ann's Block Area of Campbell River

Excavation work on the St Ann's Block Upgrade project will begin the week of July 8. Upland Excavating Ltd. will begin preparing for roadwork and major excavation in the area starting on Monday July 8. Please note the following summer closures and detours for St. Ann's Road and Dubeau Street:

SUMMER DETOURS & CLOSURES – July & August	
St Ann's Road: Alder to Shopper's Row	A section of St Ann's Rd will be closed both directions to traffic between Alder and Shopper's Row. Detours via Alder St and 10th Avenue. Road is open to local traffic to access businesses.
Dubeau Street: St. Ann's Rd to Beech Street	A section of Dubeau will be closed to traffic between St Ann's and Beech St. Detours via St Ann's Rd and Beech St. Road is open to local traffic to access businesses.

Please note:

- Local traffic can still access businesses during construction, even during road closures. This includes staff, customers, clients, delivery trucks, emergency vehicles, and anyone shopping at local businesses.
- Road detours and closures will be maintained on weekdays and weekends.
- Flaggers and traffic control personnel will assist motorists, cyclists and pedestrians.
- Detours will be well marked. Portable messaging signs will be used to inform and guide traffic.
- Transit detours and re-routes will be announced shortly.
- Fall closures and detours will occur on Alder Street and Beech Street, once Dubeau and St Ann's Road are reopened to traffic.

The City of Campbell River thanks everyone for their patience. The goal is to minimize disruption to business, traffic, and the general public while ensuring safety for everyone during construction.

The St Ann's Upgrade Project covers upgrades to underground services including sewer, water and storm drainage systems, and above ground improvements to roads, sidewalks, streetlights, and landscaping for the area connecting 10th Avenue to Shoppers Row in downtown Campbell River. The work will result in a complete civic "makeover" of the St Ann's Block area. Many of the aboveground upgrades will work together to create inviting spaces for pedestrians, cyclists and visitors.
