Next session of City's free building and land development forum Wednesday, Feb. 20

Next week's one-hour lunch 'n' learn session for local builders and developers will occur Feb. 20, focusing on proposed changes to the City's building bylaws.

The City's senior planner will provide an overview of the proposed revisions to Campbell River's existing Building Bylaw. Proposed changes address BC Building Code updates, foundation size increase for non-residential buildings, energy-efficiency fee reduction, temporary structures and more.
