- 2:30- 4 pm Public swim
- 5-6 Family swim and lengths
- 6-8 Public swim

“Summer 2013 has been a particularly busy one for the Centennial Pool,” says Ross Milnthorp, the City’s general manager of parks, recreation and culture. “All the sunny weather has brought people back time and again to enjoy this facility.”

Swimming lesson registrations totaled 1,199 at the outdoor pool this year, and heading into the last week of this year’s eight-week operating schedule, the total number of swimmers already tallied 4,271.

“Another highlight this year was the Junior Lifeguard Camp. Thanks to our highly-skilled instructor, Dayna Stevenson, participants improved their skills and learned about water safety – and many of them have expressed interest in our camp for next season,” Milnthorp adds.
