Along with the hands-on activities for the public, and fire safety displays, the schedule of events includes:

- Concession 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.
- Auto Extrication Rescue Demo 11 a.m.
- House Fire Attack Demo 1 p.m.

Due to popular demand, the aerial ladder climb will be limited to 50 people on a first-come, first-served basis. Participants must be at least five years of age.

The concession will serve hamburgers and hotdogs supplied by Quality Foods, with all proceeds going to Cameryn’s Cause.
