### **City of Campbell River water stations flowing for Canada Day festivities**

With Campbell River gearing up for another fantastic Canada Day celebration July 1, the City will provide water stations around the community to help keep residents healthy this summer.

During the spring, City of Campbell River employees installed water stations at key locations. These stations are accessible 24 hours a day, seven days a week, and will provide free access to clean, safe drinking water. These stations will continue to run throughout the summer.

*“Through the creative initiative of our water crew to recycle former fire hydrants into water stations, we are encouraging people to bring a reusable water bottle and keep hydrated during the hottest time of the year,”* says the City’s utilities project supervisor Nathalie Viau. *“The summer months in Campbell River can be very dry and hot, and these water stations will help people cope while also promoting our exceptionally clean and safe drinking water.”*
