Stay hydrated while enjoying the great outdoors in Campbell River this summer!

Water bottle filling stations are back in operation in a number of Campbell River parks.

This past week, City of Campbell River employees installed the popular water bottle filling stations at Spirit Square, Robert Ostler Park and Dick Murphy Park. Another station will be open at Frank James Park once the shoreline restoration is complete at this location at the end of the month.

These stations are accessible 24 hours a day, seven days a week and provide clean safe drinking water free of charge until the end of September.

“The summer months in Campbell River can become very dry and hot, and these filling stations will help the public cope with the heat while also promoting our clean safe drinking water,” says Nathalie Viau, the City’s water supervisor.

Feel free to make use of the stations, and don’t forget to bring your reusable bottle!
