

Robron Park Fieldhouse Civil Works Summer 2020

Complete and in-service!

Project Overview

The Robron Park Master Plan was completed in 2009 and included the concept of a central fieldhouse at the park adjacent to the artificial turf field.

The Campbell River Youth Soccer Association (CRYSA) and the City developed a partnership agreement with support from Cermaq Canada Ltd., Ketzta Pacific, Seymour Pacific, Rotary Club of Campbell River, Western Forest Products, Econobox, Interfor and MOWI towards completing this community initiative.



The City's contribution to the 4,500 square foot facility included the installation of the site civil servicing (storm, sewer, water, electrical etc.) for the building. This work was publicly tendered and awarded to Upland Contracting Ltd. and was successfully completed in 2020.

The fieldhouse was delivered in partnership with CRYSA which has an 87-person multipurpose room with a kitchen, deck, change rooms, washrooms and equipment storage space. Additionally, it also has a solar powered 12.4kW grid-tie system to offset the energy of the fieldhouse and the turf lights surrounding the field.

Funding for the Project

The site servicing was delivered under a separate contract with final costs being \$325,000 against an approved budget of \$348,000, with funding from the City's Capital Works fund.
