On Time and Under Budget!

Project Overview

Work under this project included reclaiming the biosolid application area at the Norm Wood Environmental Centre (Liquid Waste Department) under two separate phases known as Field 1 and Field 2.

Phase I took place in 2019 and consisted of rehabilitating field 1 by clearing a treed area, followed by earth works that stripped and reshaped some areas of the field. Phase II commenced in the summer of 2020 on field 2 and included the relocation of approximately 0.5 hectares of environmentally sensitive material.

Highland Engineering and Surveying Ltd. completed the design for both phases of the project. Phase I construction was completed by Wacor Holdings Ltd. and phase II was completed by Upland Contracting Ltd.



Funding for the Project

City Council approved a budget of \$500,000 for Phase I in the 2019 Budget Deliberations and \$730,000 for Phase II during the 2020 Budget Deliberations. The final cost of the project was \$829,000 and was funded by the Sewer Reserve.
