Project Overview

Work under this project included the clearing, grubbing and grading of an 11.0 hectare site adjacent to the Norm Wood Environmental Centre and relocation of the City's biosolids application process equipment. Also completed was the creation of a new Environmentally Sensitive Area serving the Casey Creek system.

Highland Engineering and Surveying Ltd. completed the detail design for this construction project which was delivered in 2 separate phases.

Construction on this 1st phase was completed by Five Star Aggregate & Excavating Ltd. of Campbell River on May 15, 2012. The 2nd phase included the relocation of approximately 0.5 hectares of environmentally sensitive area and was completed by Upland Excavating Ltd., during the summer of 2012.

Funding for the Project

The final cost of construction works associated with the Biosolids Application Area Project was \$429,570 against the approved budget of \$602,290 and was fully funded through the City's Sewer Capital Funds.
