Hwy 19 between Hwy 28 and Orange Point Rd

On Time and On Budget!

Project Overview

This project involved improvements to the water distribution system in North Campbell River including new transmission and distribution mains serving the area north of the Hwy 19/28 intersection to Orange Point Road. The project was delivered as a partnership between Capital Power Corporation and the City, and provides a new connection for the ICG2 plant to the City's water and sanitary systems and addresses a number of system pressure related issues in the area. Work under this project consisted of watermain replacement along Hwy 19 between Hwy 28 and Orange Point Rd. Part of this project also included the installation of 2 new Pressure Reducing Valve Stations.

McElhanney Consulting Services, based in Campbell River, Capital Power and the City of Campbell River completed the detail design and the project was publicly tendered in the Spring of 2012 with the tender being awarded to Wacor Holdings Ltd., of Campbell River. Construction was complete in November of 2012.



Funding for the Project

The project was funded under a partnership agreement between the City and Capital Power with the final cost of \$2.5M being just under the approved budget. The City's contribution of \$600,000 was funded through Water Capital Funds.
