On Time and Under Budget!

Project Overview

Work under this project included the replacement of three 36-year-old centrifugal blowers that process air for the oxidation ditches and aerobic digester at the sewage treatment plant. The aged blowers were at the end of their service life and were without modern controls required for efficient operation. Replacement with high efficiency turbo blowers will significantly reduce energy consumption at the plant and provide renewed system reliability.

In 2011 Opus DaytonKnight Consultants Ltd. completed the detailed design. The City purchased the replacement blowers directly from APG Neuros and in January of 2012 Ketza Pacific Construction (1993) Ltd. completed the installation contract.

Funding for the Project

The approved budget for the installation of the City provided blowers was \$663,348 with all necessary works being completed at \$619,680.

Funding for this project was a combination of Sewer Capital and grant funding through BC Hydro.
