Project Overview

CRadvantage is a key economic driver that strengthens existing businesses and draws new investment to Campbell River. This municipal broadband service offers an open model for third party service providers to lease network access. For more information on this initiative visit <https://cradvantage.com/>.

Work under this phase of the project included the extension of the City's municipal broadband network along 10th Avenue between Cedar and Alder streets, and on 11th Avenue from the Community Centre across to the laneway behind the Tidemark Theatre and library where they will be connected.

The civil design work and contract administration was completed by the City's Capital Works Department. Installation was completed by Lite Access Technologies (Canada) Inc.



Funding for the Project

City Council approved these locations during the 2021 - 2030 Capital Plan budget deliberations. Work was completed under the approved budget of \$172,000 and funded by the Community Works Fund.
