We're Getting Ready—Here's What You Need to Know

Municipal Utility Upgrade Work Beginning Soon!



Work under this project includes the expansion of the City's municipal broadband network in the downtown core. Micro-duct conduit and broadband fibre is being installed on 10th Avenue between Alder and Beech streets, and from the Community Centre to the Tidemark Theatre and Library. This will allow for expansion of current service area and provide increased opportunity to access the City's CR advantage program.

Getting Ready for Construction

We are just finalizing details with the work; anticipated to commence in early June and be completed by the end of June. This work is limited to the road right of way and local residents and businesses may experience minor inconveniences as the installation progresses.



Traffic and Parking Disruptions

This project requires a single lane closure and restrictions to parking, including the temporary reduction of parking stalls in the City owned lot at 325 Beech Street. See photo below. Our goal is to minimize traffic disruptions and keep traffic flowing. The contractor will be required to maintain appropriate traffic control throughout the course of construction and ensure driveway access is maintained at all times. Signs will be posted to provide clear direction for drivers and pedestrians travelling around the active work zone.

Work will take place between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday.
