

MUNICIPAL BROADBAND NETWORK INSTALLATION PROJECT

Spring 2017 to Fall 2017



Project Overview

This project included the installation of micro-duct conduit to service strategic locations in the downtown core with broadband fibre. The area covered by this work transitioned from St. Ann's Road to Alder Street, Beech Street to Cedar Street and terminated at 11th Avenue.

With service now available to buildings in the downtown core, CRadvantage is a key economic driver that strengthens existing businesses and draws new investment to Campbell River. The municipal broadband service offers an open model for third party service providers to lease network access.

The civil design work was completed by the City's Capital Works Department and the tender for construction was approved by City Council and awarded to TeraSpan Networks Inc. with work completed in fall of 2017.

The City received a Smart 50 Networks Award for the CRadvantage project. Each year, Smart 50 Awards honour the most innovative and influential technology projects around the world.



Funding for the Project

The project was in the approved 2017 Capital Plan with a total budget of \$373,000. It was funded by the Community Works Fund and a grant from the Island Coastal Economic Trust.
