

# NORM WOOD ENVIRONMENTAL CENTRE (NVEC) UPGRADE PHASE 2

Spring 2016 to Fall 2016

*On Time and Under Budget!*


## Project Overview

Work under this phase included upgrading the City's existing sewage treatment facility, Norm Wood Environmental Centre, to improve efficiency, provide required system redundancy, and to address existing operational deficiencies. This project included upgrades to the headworks (sewage screening system), sani-dump receiving facilities, additional aeration oxidation ditch piping, additional WAS pumping capacity, building HVAC improvements, biofilter roof replacement and electrical system upgrades.

Design was completed by Opus International and construction work was delivered by Ridgeline Mechanical Ltd. Construction was complete in December 2016.

## Funding for the Project

The project was funded through a combination of Sewer Accumulated Surplus and Sewer Development Cost Charges. The final total cost of design and construction works associated with the Norm Wood Environmental Centre Upgrade - Phase 2 was \$1.6 million against the approved \$2.5 million dollar budget.
