

Q & A: 2021 Sewermain Rehabilitation Projects

The 2021 Sewermain Rehabilitation Project is commencing soon.

The following questions and answers are intended to provide an overview of this project.

1. What is the project?

Work under this contract consists of the rehabilitation of approximately 4200 lineal metres of existing sanitary sewer mains through Trenchless Technology and the Cured In Place Pipe (CIPP) lining method. The work will be delivered in 53 distinct segments as defined by manhole to manhole sections of relevant sewermain pipe and service connections.

2. Where are the 2021 project locations?

- 11th Ave from Shoppers Row to Cedar St
- Laneway behind the 1100 block of Shoppers Row to Cedar St
- Cedar St from 11th Ave to 13th Ave
- Cypress St from 11th Ave to 13th Ave
- 13th Ave from Cypress St to and past Dogwood St approximately 30 metres
- Dogwood St from 7th Ave to 9th Ave
- 8th Ave from Dogwood to Greenwood St
- Greenwood from 8th Ave to 12th Ave
- 9th Ave from Greenwood St to Dogwood St
- Maple St from Island Hwy to 20th Ave
- 20th Ave
- 19th Ave from Maple to Petersen Rd
- Laneway behind 1661 block of Island Hwy
- Redwood St from 16th Ave to Island Hwy
- 16th Ave from Redwood St to Tamarac St
- 17th Ave from Redwood St to Tamarac St
- Spruce St from 16th Ave to Island Hwy
- 1000 block of Shoppers Row

3. When is the construction work going to take place?

Construction is expected to commence this summer and be completed by fall 2021.

4. What is the cost of the project?

The final cost of the project is estimated at \$1.1 million.

5. How is the project being funded?

Budget has been approved in the 2021 Capital Plan and is funded by the Sewer Reserve.

6. Who will be involved in the project design and construction?

The work is being completed under a design-bid-built model. Design has been completed by the City's Capital Works and Sewer Departments. RFP 19-14 for construction was awarded to Insituform Technologies Ltd.

7. What do I need to know?

Your sewer service connection to the sewer mainline will have to be **temporarily closed off** during repairs. We need your cooperation to avoid back up of the sewer water into your residence or business by preventing water from entering the sewer through any drains during the specified time period. As a result, it is imperative that you do not perform the following household activities.

Please: avoid washing clothes, dishes, do not take showers or baths, do not flush toilets or operate sump pumps connected to the sewer system

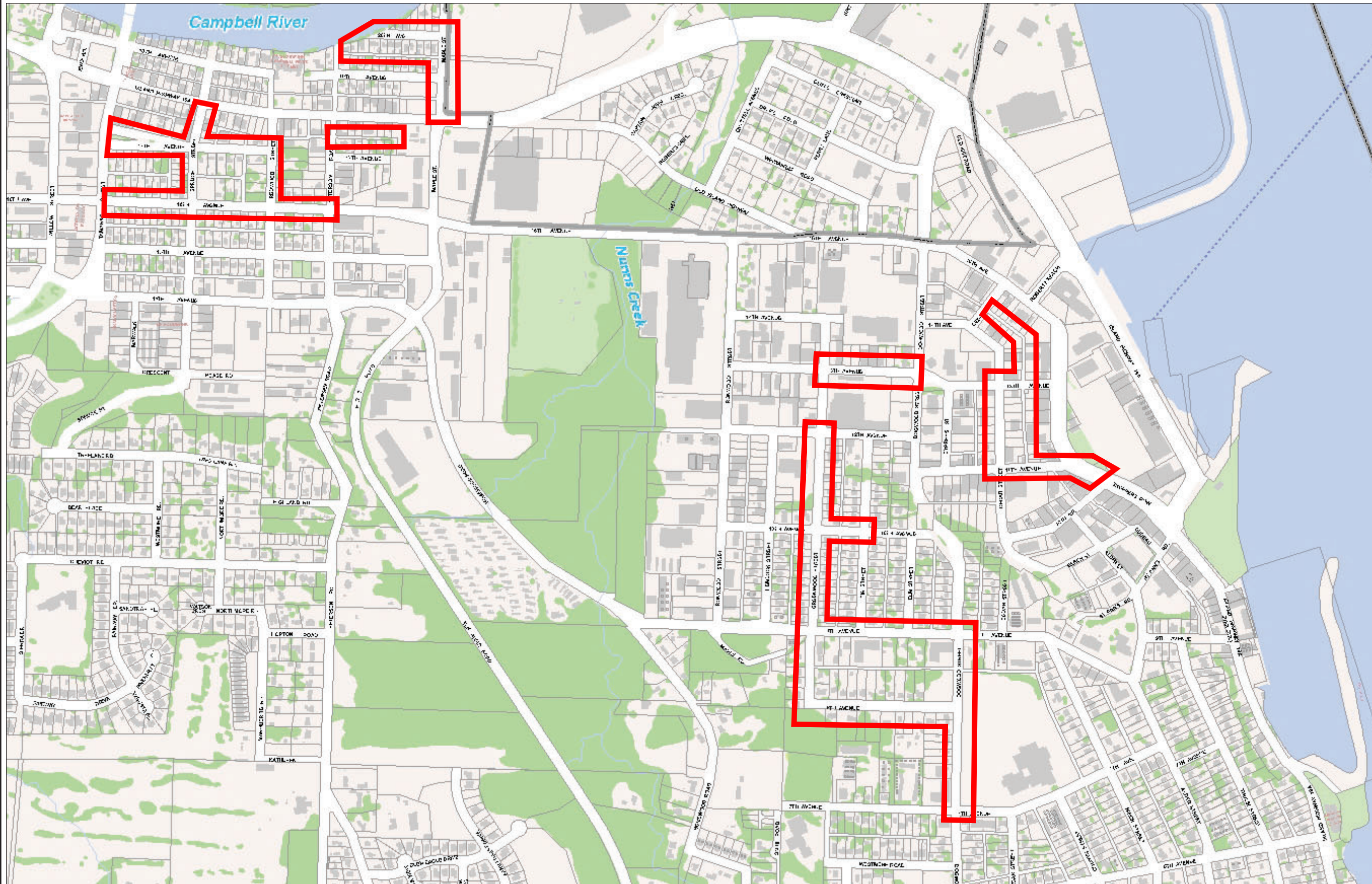
