

The City of Campbell River will be completing the watermain upgrades on Hilchey Rd. that were started in 2021.

1. What is this project?

Work under these renewal projects consists of installing new watermains and domestic services throughout Campbell River. These new mains are to replace the sections of the water distribution system that have reached the end of their useful service life.

2. What are we doing, and when are we doing it?

Beginning mid to late March, depending upon weather, we will be completing upgrades of the watermain on Hilchey Rd. between Dalton Rd. and Hwy. 19A. This work will include excavation of the roadway and relocation of water services up to your property line. The contractor will be restoring disturbed areas upon completion of the project.

Work is targeted for completion by the end of April, followed by paving and road marking restoration.

You can expect work to be performed between the hours of 7:00 am and 6:00 pm, Monday to Friday.

3. Who will be involved in the project?

The design work was completed under a design-bid-build model by the City's Capital Projects and Water Departments. The construction contract was awarded to Wacor Holdings Ltd.

4. How will traffic be managed during the project?

We anticipate changes to the flow of local traffic during construction. A traffic management plan will be reviewed by the City and implemented by Wacor Holdings Ltd. at the start of the project.
