## READY TO ROLL

To meet Campbell River's vision of continued growth, new opportunities and the celebration of the community's waterfront, an extensive three-year upgrade project begins this summer.

The waterfront improvement project includes three key upgrades: renewal of the waterfront sewer line between Rockland Road and the Maritime Heritage Centre, a rebuild of the Big Rock Boat Ramp and the next phase of Highway 19A improvements.

The first step in this important work will involve improvements to the waterfront sewer line – a critical piece of infrastructure that was originally built in 1972. Work will begin in June 2018, at the southern entrance to the downtown – from the Maritime Heritage Centre to 1st Avenue.


## LIVING AND WORKING NEAR CONSTRUCTION

This summer, construction will be focused between the Maritime Heritage Centre and 1st Avenue. The project team recognizes that this is a critical route for commuters and visitors to the city and that extensive road work will pose a challenge. To minimize impacts of construction, the project team will:

- Keep people informed of the work and traffic impacts
- Encourage the use of alternative routes
- Maintain two-way traffic as much as possible

We encourage residents to continue their support of local businesses who may see changes to access and traffic flows as work takes place.

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## BIG ROCK BOAT RAMP UPGRADES



JUNE-OCTOBER 2018

*In-water improvements*

We know many people along this corridor are also active users of the Big Rock Boat Ramp – which will undergo significant upgrades to the in-water area over the summer months of 2018.

The new design will focus on improving safety and ease of use for all boaters and anglers. The ramp will close for construction in June and re-open in October.

## WATERFRONT SEWER UPGRADES



PART 1: JUNE-SEPT 2018

*1st Ave to Maritime Heritage Centre*

The work involves:

- Renew/upgrade sanitary sewer lines on Hwy 19A from Rockland Road to Maritime Heritage Centre. This includes;
  - Install new forcemain along Hwy 19A road right of way from Lift Station No. 7 (Simm's Creek) to 1st Ave
  - Install new gravity main from 1st Ave to Maritime Heritage Centre
- Upgrade affected lift (pump) stations along the route
- Connect the new sewer to new and existing lift stations
- Existing forcemain, connecting Hwy 19A from Hidden Harbour to Maritime Heritage Centre, to remain in place
- Create new lift station to connect properties on east side of Hwy 19A from 1st to 3rd avenues
- Address several existing gravity main connections

*1st Ave to Big Rock Boat Ramp*

## HIGHWAY 19A UPGRADES



PHASE 3: 2020

*Area: 1 km – 300 m south of Rockland Road to the southern limit of McCallum Park*

The work involves:

- Reconstruction of 1km of Hwy 19A from Lift Station No. 7 (Simm's Creek) to Big Rock Boat Ramp
- Significant reconstruction/upgrade of sewer and watermains
- Install storm drains
- Widen roadway, sidewalk, seawalk
- Add streetlights, enhance park spaces and waterfront areas
- Install underground electrical utilities
- Improve highway function, install Rockland roundabout
- Prepare waterfront for changes due to sea level rise

## KEEPING YOU INFORMED

As construction work is scheduled along the Highway 19A corridor, the project team – using news bulletins like these and other tools – will keep people informed. We will also reach out to homes and businesses in construction areas, prior to work starting.
