BYLAW NO. 3289

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELL RIVER TO IMPOSE A PARCEL TAX FOR FUNDING THE ACQUISITION, DEVELOPMENT AND IMPROVEMENT OF PARKS AND TRAILS.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Parks Parcel Tax Assessment Roll Bylaw No. 3288, 2007, an assessment roll has been prepared for the purposes of imposing a parcel tax to cover all or part of the costs for the acquisition, development and improvement of Parks and Trails;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Campbell River, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

TITLE

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the **“Parks Parcel Tax Bylaw No. 3289, 2007”**.

DEFINITIONS

2. “Parcel” means any lot, block or other area in which land is held or into which it is subdivided, but does not include a highway.

PARCEL TAX IMPOSITION

3. (a) A parcel tax shall be imposed on all parcels within the city, other than those that are exempt under the *Local Government Act* or the *Community Charter* or another act to cover the costs related to the acquisition, development and improvement of parks and trails.

- (b) The parcel tax shall be imposed for a period of ten (10) years running from the year 2020 through 2029.

The parcel tax shall be levied on each parcel listed in the Parks Assessment Roll for the year 2020 or as that roll may be amended and authenticated from time to time thereafter in accordance with the provisions of the *Community Charter*.

- (c) The parcel tax hereby imposed on each parcel of land shall be \$37 for 2020-2029.
