- PROCLAMATION -

- WHEREAS** Campbell River is a society open to everyone, including the 2SLGBTQIA+ (Two-Spirit, Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Trans, Queer, Questioning, Intersex and Asexual) gender diverse and gender non-binary community, who play an important part in the rich fabric of our local diversity and will celebrate Campbell River Pride on Saturday, June 24, 2023;
- AND WHEREAS** we encourage, honour and respect the diversity and the affirmation of everyone, we offer the recognition of dignity and worth of all people; regardless of their sexual orientation, gender identity and gender expression, regardless of their sex, age, class, race, creed, religion, ability;
- AND WHEREAS** the BC Human Rights Code and the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms recognizes that no discrimination shall be made on the basis of sexual orientation, gender identity or gender expression;
- AND WHEREAS** the United Nations' Universal Declaration of Human Rights states that all human beings are born free and equal in dignity and rights;
- AND WHEREAS** Campbell River's community members have taken a leadership role in the fight for the elimination of all forms of discrimination and are committed to equal treatment for all people and their right to live in conditions of dignity, respect, peace;
- AND WHEREAS** with acknowledgement of this day to make the general public more aware of 2SLGBTQIA+ issues –in our own community and beyond – and to further the inclusion and celebration of 2SLGBTQIA+ persons in all areas of society. Our city pledges to continue to work to create safer and more inclusive spaces –for all its citizens.
- NOW THEREFORE I, Kermit Dahl, Mayor of the City of Campbell River** do hereby proclaim June 24, 2023, to be observed as:

"CAMPBELL RIVER 2SLGBTQIA+ PRIDE DAY"
