- AND WHEREAS: The Day of Mourning was initiated by the Canadian Labour Congress in 1984, and Canada was the first country to formally recognize this day now observed around the world;
- AND WHEREAS: Each year, workers and employers, family members of fatally injured workers and representatives from all levels of government are invited to participate in the *Day of Mourning* to honour the memory of lost workers and to increase public awareness of occupational health and safety;
- AND WHEREAS: The loss of life at work is tragic and preventable, and through observing the *Day of Mourning*, we honour those who have passed away and remind our community to renew their commitment to ensure all workers are safe on the job.
