tan, is indicative of UV damage;

AND WHEREAS skin self-examinations should be performed on a monthly basis because

skin cancers are highly treatable when detected early;

melanoma skin cancers, melanoma and ocular melanoma through

nationwide education, advocacy and awareness initiatives;
