NOTICE OF INTENTION TO PROVIDE ASSISTANCE BY WAY OF PARTNERING AGREEMENTS

Campbell River City Council intends to provide assistance to:

- Heart of the City Business Improvement Area Association under the terms of a partnering agreement for the provision of services to beautify public property in the downtown area, including pressure washing sidewalks and maintaining flower pots along Shoppers Row, purchasing Christmas lights, wrapping four BC Hydro boxes, and performing maintenance on the Spider public art installation. The agreement is for work to be done in 2018 and the extent of the City's assistance under the partnering agreement shall not exceed \$8,733.96.
- Willow Point Business Improvement Area Society under the terms of a partnering agreement for the provision of services to beautify public property in the Willow Point area, by purchasing 10 hanging flower baskets, Christmas decorations, LED lights, and hiring musical entertainment for Canada Day Celebrations. The agreement is for work to be done in 2018 and the extent of the City's assistance under the partnering agreement shall not exceed \$5.800.00.
- Campbellton Neighbourhood Association under the terms of a partnering agreement for the provision of services to beautify public property in the Campbellton area, by replanting and watering flower boxes, constructing 6 additional planters, and purchasing 10 banners. The agreement is for work to be done in 2018 and the extent of the City's assistance under the partnering agreement shall not exceed \$10,000.00.
- Pier Street Association under the terms of a partnering agreement for the provision of services to beautify public property in the Pier Street area of downtown, by repairing planters, pressure washing sidewalks, landscaping, and purchasing two new benches.
 The agreement is for work to be done in 2018 and the extent of the City's assistance under the partnering agreement shall not exceed \$7,500.00.

The draft partnering agreements and records relating to the proposed assistance are available for public inspection between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays, at City Hall, 301 St. Ann's Road, Campbell River.
