## KEN FORDE BOAT RAMP ACCESS

### CURRENT STATUS

City crews will remove gravel from the ramp and the facility will be open for the remainder of the summer for trailered boat access. Working with a qualified environmental professional, the **ramp will be cleared** at the next sufficiently low tide (anticipated July 19-21).


### WHAT'S THE CHALLENGE?

Due to location, currents and wind, the ramp collects debris and gravel and needs regular maintenance. Cleaning the ramp must consider natural cycles, impacts on the marine environment, and federal regulations.
