PUBLIC HEARING - HAVE YOUR SAY! WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 23, 2022 AT 6 P.M.

DETAILS: The City has received an application for a Zoning Bylaw Amendment at 2079 and 2099 Mereroft Road. The amendment proposes to rezone the properties from Residential Estate (RE-1) Zone to Residential One A (R-1A) Zone and Residential Multiple Two (RM-2) Zone to allow for a future low to medium density residential subdivision, including single-family dwellings with suites and multi-family housing, totalling approximately 400 units. The proposed concept plan includes a public road, park space and environmental buffer areas.


