DETAILS: The purpose of the proposed Zoning Bylaw Amendment is to allow for a future low- to medium-density residential subdivision, including single-family dwellings with suites and multi-family housing, totalling approximately 400 units. The proposed concept plan includes a public road, park space and environmental buffer areas.
