

THE CITY IS UPDATING ITS MASTER TRANSPORTATION PLAN



The City is inviting residents to have their say and complete the Master Transportation Plan survey by Aug. 6, 2022. The Plan will explore walking, cycling, transit and car use in Campbell River, with potential projects over the next 20 years as well as a Dogwood Corridor Study, which will look at opportunities to improve active transportation options while maintaining the mobility of the corridor for vehicle traffic and business access.


