



PUBLIC HEARING - HAVE YOUR SAY! WEDNESDAY, JULY 6, 2022 AT 6 P.M.

DETAILS: The purpose of this Official Community Plan Amendment Bylaw is to improve the Hazard Conditions (Steep Slope) Development Permit Area guidelines for human safety and to reduce the risk of landslides.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION: Various locations across the City. The Development Permit Area applies to lands:

- Within 20 metres of a slope that is both at least 30% grade and 10 metres high from the crest to the toe.
