

## PUBLIC NOTICE – PARCEL TAX REVIEW PANEL FOR WATER, SEWER, STORMWATER AND PARKS PARCEL TAX ASSESSMENT PURPOSES

NOTICE is hereby given that a Parcel Tax Review Panel for Water, Sewer, Stormwater and Parks Parcel Tax Assessment purposes will be held at 10 a.m. on Thursday, May 11, 2023 to hear complaints regarding the Water, Sewer, Stormwater and Parks Rolls for the year 2023.

You may make a complaint under *Section 205 of the Community Charter to the Parcel Tax Review Panel* for one or more of the following reasons:

- There is an error or omission about a name or address on the tax roll;
- There is an error or omission about the inclusion of a parcel;
- There is an error or omission about the taxable area or taxable frontage of a parcel;
- An exemption has been improperly allowed.

For a complaint to be heard by the Parcel Tax Review Panel, it must be received via email by [Mark.Coulter@campbellriver.ca](mailto:Mark.Coulter@campbellriver.ca) before **4 p.m. on May 8, 2023**.

Be sure to state the address of the property in question and the reason for your appeal. **Notice given April 26, 2023.**

## SERVE YOUR COMMUNITY ON THE BOARD OF VARIANCE

The City of Campbell River is looking for two appointments, for a term ending **March 31, 2026**.

The Board of Variance considers minor variances to the City's Zoning Bylaw. No specific knowledge or qualifications are necessary. If you have an interest in governance and land use regulations, this may be the position for you.

Appeals to the Board are generally made by homeowners or developers when compliance with a minor aspect of a Zoning Bylaw (such as a side yard setback) would cause "hardship" to the applicant. The Board will consider whether the application is "minor" and whether "hardship" is evident and will either deny or approve an application.

The Board hears representations from an applicant and/or their neighbours before making a decision. City staff provide administrative and technical support.

Members must be available to meet during working hours with at least 10 days' notice. The Board meets for approximately an hour when applications are received, typically 3 to 5 times a year.

**Applications must be received by 4:30 p.m. on April 28, 2023.**
