STAYING WATER WISE IN CAMPBELL RIVER

Did you know? Peak periods for water use happen in July and August – mainly due to garden and lawn irrigation.

FOLLOW THESE TIPS TO KEEP YOUR OUTDOOR GREEN AREAS HEALTHY, WHILE CONSERVING WATER:

- Water your lawn in the morning or evening when current restrictions allow
- **♦** Control the flow of your hose with an automatic shut-off nozzle
- ♠ Check outdoor taps and irrigation systems for leaks
- ▲ Re-use greywater from indoor showers and taps
- ▲ Use a rain barrel to collect water
