ORGANICS REMINDERS

-  Campbell River accepts **food and yard waste year-round** as part of the weekly curbside collection program.
-  There is a 360-litre limit, per household, per week.
-  Use strong lidded containers for your exterior bins made of plastic, rubber, or galvanized steel.
-  Yard waste, like lawn clippings and leaves, **that does not contain food waste**, may be placed in paper yard waste bags.
