PROPERTY AGREEMENTS NOTICE

The City of Campbell River intends to lease the following lands and building space:

- 10-year Building Access Agreement with Shaw Telecom G.P. for the purpose of installing, operating and maintaining new telecommunications equipment at 4000 Island Highway (Norm Wood Environmental Centre). After the initial 10-year term the Building Access Agreement will transition to consecutive one-year terms.

The City also intends to enter into the following agreement at the Campbell River Airport:



- 25-year lease that will terminate on May 31, 2048, with an option to renew for 3 further terms of 25-years, to Broadstreet Properties Ltd., for an initial annual rent of \$20,559.20 plus GST. (Lease Area 24, 8,290 m2, Plan EPP52073)
- 25-year lease that will terminate on May 31, 2048, with an option to renew for 3 further terms of 25-years, to 1329388 B.C. Ltd. (BC1329388), for an initial annual rent of \$20,599.20 plus GST. (Lease Area 25, 8,290 m2, Plan EPP52073)

The City will remain the registered, fee-simple owner of all lands and buildings described above. This notice is given pursuant to Section 26 of the Community Charter.
