## COVID-SAFE TRIVIA NIGHT COMING UP

Looking for a fun way to get together with your safe six? Sign up for Trivia Night Nov. 6 at the Campbell River Community Centre.

*“Due to COVID-19 safety requirements, seats are limited, and well-spaced tables are restricted to six people,”* explains recreation manager Michele Sirett. *“This is an opportunity for your safe six to join us for an interactive and entertaining evening that supports local recreation programming for people with special needs.”*

The event will be held in the gymnasium to allow ample physical distancing. As another safety precaution, teams are encouraged to bring their own snacks.

*“The Rec Department is taking all precautions to ensure this is a COVID-safe event,”* Sirett adds. *“This small social event is designed to allow people to get out and socialize with their COVID cohort.”*

Trivia Night is for people aged 19 years or older and includes a cash bar. Doors will open at 6:30 p.m., with the quiz running from 7 to 9 p.m.

The cost per team is \$60, with all proceeds going towards specialized recreation programs. All teams must pre-register with their team name, names of team members and phone numbers. Register at [campbellriver.ca/online-registration](http://campbellriver.ca/online-registration).

At the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic, the City’s recreation department quickly moved specialized recreation programs online, including Coffee & Connections, Zumba, Singing for Fun and Evening Social.

Today, some programs continue on Zoom, some are back in person with physical distancing, and a few are available using both methods.

*“Funds raised through Trivia Night will help us continue to provide a range of programs at low cost for the participants,”* Sirett says.

The profound impact of these programs is summed up in remarks by families and caregivers, such as:

- “This is his place to shine.”
- “It a safe place to be yourself.”
- “We see much more independence learned.”
- “She tries new things at program.”
- “It’s good for him to have the independent connection to his peers.”
- “We saw him smiling a lot, and he certainly enjoys seeing his friends and the support staff that he misses.”
