

Declaration of State of Local Emergency ORDER

WHEREAS there is a landslide within the jurisdiction of the City of Campbell River;

AND WHEREAS the landslide poses an existing or imminent threat to people and property within the area known as:

- South Island Highway South
- Ash Street

AND WHEREAS this landslide emergency requires prompt coordination of action or special regulation of persons or property to protect the health, safety or welfare of people or to limit damage to property;

NOW THEREFORE:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED pursuant to Section 12 (1) of the Emergency Program Act that a state of local emergency exists in the Ash Street and Island Highway South due to a landslide and potential risk for continued slope failure.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the City of Campbell River, its employees, servants and agents are empowered pursuant to Section 13 (1) of the Emergency Program Act to do all acts and implement all procedures that are considered necessary to prevent or to alleviate the effects of the emergency.

ORDERED by Mayor Kermit Dahl this date, 01/19/2023, to remain in force for seven days until 01/26/2023 at midnight unless cancelled by City of Campbell River or the Minister responsible.
