New advisory committee volunteers fill vacancies

Two new volunteers are joining City advisory committees and others are being re-appointed as terms end for some of the current members.

Council appointed William Wagner to the Community Planning Advisory Committee for a three-year term ending March 31, 2022. This committee considers matters related to long-range and parks planning, Official Community Plan and Zoning bylaws, affordable housing, development issues and opportunities, public art, community wellbeing through sustainable neighbourhood development and downtown revitalization

Bruce Woytuik will join the Tourism Advisory Committee for a two-year term ending Dec. 31, 2021.

Three members of the Tourism Advisory Committee have been reappointed as representatives of the accommodation sector: Paul Dowler, Jonathan Shead and Bev Herperger.
