New four-way stops at two Campbell River intersections

New signs will be in place to create four-way stops at the intersection of Alder and Evergreen and at Birch and Evergreen by noon today.

In an effort to improve safety at these intersections, Council directed staff to install four-way stop signs at these intersections during the Dec. 11 meeting.

“The direction is in response to public concerns about changing and increased traffic along Evergreen as a result of the new hospital,” says Drew Hadfield, the City’s transportation manager. “Drivers are reminded to use caution proceeding from these four-way stops as people adjust to the new signs. And please, take extra care on the roads wherever you are during the busy holiday season.”
