
Sewermain Rehabilitation work will be starting in your area

WE'RE GETTING READY—HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

Since 2016 the City of Campbell River has been utilizing trenchless technologies to rehabilitate some if its aging underground infrastructure. When applicable, the City prefers to use a cured in place pipe (CIPP) solution. This technology is very quick and cost effective when compared to the conventional method involving deep trench excavations and undesirable property disruptions.



A sewer rehabilitation program is completed each year by the City to continue to improve the underground sewer collection systems within our community. This year we are targeting to complete approximately 3.5 kilometers of CIPP to rehabilitate our sewer mains that have reached the end of their serviceable life. Locations for this years program can be found on the attached map.

We would like to advise you that our contractor will be installing CIPP in your neighborhood this year. **Aegion, Insituform Technologies Ltd.**, will have equipment onsite performing the work. Work is expected to start in June and be complete by September 2022.

Getting Ready for Construction

Preparation work, such as sewer cleaning, will be completed in June by the contractor. The contractor will then return to your location to install the CIPP at a later date. While the work is being performed, your sanitary sewer connection may be temporarily sealed off. In advance of the work, the contractor (Insituform Technologies Ltd.), will notify you directly if there are any disruptions to your service and will be providing you with more specific information and instructions.

Residential areas:

Majority of this work will take place during the day between <u>7:00am and 7:00pm</u>. Service interruptions typically last 3-5 hours.

Commercial areas:

For some commercial areas, you may receive a separate notice if the work will take place at night between <u>7:00pm and 6:00am</u>. This may be required to avoid impacts to traffic and business hours. Please contact us if you have any concerns regarding night work.
